Chairman Duncan presented Commissioner Chustz with a plaque commemorating her completion of Commissioners College during the 2023 ARELLO Conference.

### VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- 1. <u>Budget</u>. Commissioner Major reported regarding the Commission's budget report (Exhibit C).
- 2. <u>Education</u>. Secretary Devillier provided an update on the 2025 Mandatory Course, reminding the Commissioners of details from the previous regular meeting where Commissioner Ritchie suggested the idea of focusing the course on buyer brokerage. Ms. Mire presented a proposal from Lynn Madison to develop the four-hour mandatory course on buyer brokerage. Ms. Mire stated the course will cover buyer representation on both sides and provide live training sessions and an online course. Vice Chair Pappalardo made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Cornner, and unanimously approved to move forward with developing a mandatory course on buyer brokerage.

Ms. Mire added that she is in the process of soliciting feedback from continuing

education vendors, schools, and others on the current continuing education approval guidelines. Ms. Mire stated that she hopes to have more information available at the next Commission meeting in May.

- 3. <u>Legal / Legislative</u>. Mr. Devillier stated that the LREC sponsored HB155 has not been scheduled for Senate introduction yet. Mr. Devillier stated that he has no concerns with the bill as it currently stands, it just hasn't been scheduled at this time. Mr. Devillier also provided updates on HB959 and SB456. Mr. Devillier stated that both bills are being monitored by the Commission. Mr. Devillier concluded his report by stating that he was asked by Secretary Devillier to monitor legislation on squatters in Louisiana. Mr. Devillier stated that there are currently two bills on this subject, one of which has recently passed the House. That bill would increase criminal penalties for squatters.

- 5. <u>Technology</u>. Ms. Mire provided an update on the LREC website project stating that the Commission has received several proposals to redesign the Commission's website. Ms. Mire added that the Commission is awaiting a few additional details from one of the companies before moving forward in the process.

Ms. Mire stated that the LREC will host the morning walk and asked all Commissioners to attend. Ms. Mire also added that she will serve on a fair housing panel on Wednesday.
